


SHOULD I RETURN TO MASS?



The chart on the back is intended to assist individuals in deciding whether coming to Mass now is the right decision for them.


If you answered “YES” to all of these questions, you should prayerfully consider coming to a Mass (any day of the week, not necessarily a weekend Mass).

Similarly, if you answered “NO” to any of these questions (or if you have safety concerns), this should guide individual decision-making on whether it is safe and appropriate for you to go to Mass at this time.



Fr. Aaron is very grateful that all who have been attending Mass have been faithful about wearing masks and cleaning places they have touched. He is hopeful that this will continue.


Are you healthy, and not knowingly exposed?




Are you free of all COVID-19-like symptoms, and feel 100%?




Are you free of any underlying health or risk issues?




There is no one in your home, or that you directly care for, that has underlying health issues or is vulnerable to infection.




Are you younger than 65 years old?




Can you come to Mass without children under the age of 5 and without children with special needs?
