

Starting July 4, Masses will be inside our buildings. Based on the recommendations of the committees, we have come up with the following arrangements for weekend Masses.

Since dispensation from assisting at Mass remains in effect, *I ask that you please stay home if you are not feeling well for any reason, are in a high risk group or if you are caring for someone who is ill.*

Mass schedule and procedures:

- Saturday 5:00PM Vigil and Sunday 8:30 AM
- Saturday Vigil Mass will be in the parish hall until further notice
- Sunday 8:30 am Mass will be in the church
- Seating will be limited by social distancing guidelines, and will be on a First-come-First-served basis.
- Radio broadcast from parking lot will be available. Anyone unable or who prefer not to enter may remain in their cars in the parking lot to hear mass and will receive communion outside under the parish hall canopy
- Due to the rising number of new cases, in order to minimize the risk of infection mask wearing is mandatory inside the buildings until further notice, and we ask that you please oblige the ushers who will advise you on health codes, out of charity and respect for people's sensibilities.
- Volunteers will make sure that the church is kept sanitized and clean after each service
- These guidelines may change or new ones may be added as per directives from local, state or diocesan authorities

**Order of Internal Mass:**

- Ushers/greeters would be positioned as follows to sustain distancing guidelines:
- No Holy Water
- No bringing up of gifts
- Collection baskets would be placed at collection points
- Communion to be distributed after mass as people exit at the end of Mass
- Ushers will manage movement of parishioners down the aisle for communion.
- People will enter from front and exit out the side doors
- Eucharistic minister(s) outside will distribute communion to those listening to mass in the parking lot under the hall canopy
