

## **"Join Us At The Table"**

Have you considered joining the Catholic Church???

You may be regularly or occasionally attending Mass, but you have another faith background like Lutheran, Episcopalian, Methodist, Greek Orthodox, or Presbyterian, to name a few.

If this is your background then, "Join Us At The Table", may be your answer for looking into the Catholic faith tradition.

Ask yourself the following questions:

1. Have I been baptized in another faith tradition?
2. Did I receive religious education in another faith tradition?
3. Do I want to receive Eucharist and the other sacraments in the Catholic Church'?

If your answer to the questions is, "yes", then the process called "Join Us At The Table", is meant for you.

This process prepares you to join the Catholic faith when you feel ready, along with having a clear understanding, and acceptance of the Catholic teachings. There are no RCIA rites connected to this process, so you are able to receive the sacraments at any time of the year. This process will be fitted to where you are on your journey of faith. ## **RCIA**

Have you considered joining the Catholic Church???

You may be regularly or occasionally attending Mass and you don't have another church you call home and especially if you haven't or don't know if you've been baptized or even if you were able to answer yes to the questions for "Join Us At The Table" (on the flip side) and you want to explore the Catholic faith, then RCIA is for you.

We have a number of prayer leaders who will share with you the Gospel for the day, knowledgeable presenters who will share about important topics of the Catholic Church, and sponsors who will dedicate themselves to you to walk this journey with you. This is the same for both RCIA and "Join Us At The Table."

The RCIA process prepares you to join the Catholic faith if that is what you want. It starts on September 23rd this year and finishes at the Easter Vigil on April 20th, 2019, where candidates receive Baptism if needed and Confirmation and then join us at the table for their first Communion.
