

# Resurrection Parish School of Religion discipline policy

In order to make the most of our limited time together and to respect the dignity of each person Resurrection Parish PSR program will be utilizing the following discipline policy.

Since young people put forth their best effort when provided with positive recognition our catechists will decide on the positive recognition that works best for their class.

With Jesus as our model, basic guidelines for classroom behavior are:

~Students are expected to speak respectfully to the teacher and others.

~Students should listen when others are talking and follow directions the first time they are given.

~Students should not leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher and students grades 6 and younger should not be upstairs without an adult at any time.

~Students should put forth their best effort

If a student fails to follow these guidelines he or she will incur the following consequences:

1<sup>st</sup> Consequence...student will receive a warning

2<sup>nd</sup> Consequence...Catechist will notify the parent and the PSR Co-Directors of the child's misbehavior

3<sup>rd</sup> Consequence...The student will be removed from the classroom and taken to one of the Co-Directors of PSR and the parents will be contacted

In the event that any student severely disrupts the class (ex. fighting, swearing) the 3<sup>rd</sup> consequence will be followed immediately.
