

Ways to Cultivate- Count the good things (blessings) in one's life; express gratitude even when it is difficult **Prayer**- Dear Jesus, please give me a thankful heart, realizing that all I have comes from You.

We are excited to introduce the **Saintly Service Award**, created to honor members of our St. Felix Catholic School faculty and staff who embody Christ's love through exceptional service and daily virtue. Inspired by saints who shaped the Church through education and compassion, this program will highlight a different saint and virtue each month to guide and uplift our school community.

Here's how it works:

- Each month from October through April, we'll feature one saint and virtue.
- Nominations open on the 1st and close on the 15th of each month.



Did you know that St. Felix and St. Agnes subscribe to Formed, a Catholic streaming platform developed by the Augustine Institute? To gain access to Formed's many movies, TV shows, and books, follow these steps:

- 1. Go to formed.org and click on "Formed for Parishes"
- 2. Click on "Find Your Parish Subscription"
- 3. (If one appears, click the "Sign Up/Sign In" button)
- 4. Enter "St Felix" into the search bar—our parishes should be the first option; you will be able to tell because of the zip code.
- 5. After that, you may be prompted to create a login, which you can then do.
- 6. You should now have access to Formed!

Diocese of Winona-Rochester - Child Sexual Abuse Policy Information

The Diocese of Winona-Rochester will provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employees, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should call the Victim Assistance Coordinator at 507-454-2270, Extension 255. A caller will be asked to provide his or her name and telephone number. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. The Diocese of Winona-Rochester is committed to protecting children, young people and other vulnerable people in our schools, parishes and ministries. The diocesan policy is available on the diocesan web site at www.dowr.org under the Safe Environment Program. If you have any questions about the Diocese of Winona's implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, please contact Michael Gerard, at 507-361-3377, or mgerard@dowr.org.

Anyone working or volunteering in a Catholic parish or school is a mandated reporter. Anyone who knows or has reason to believe that a minor (a person under the age of 18) or vulnerable adult is or has been abused or neglected, must report all suspected abuse or neglect to proper civil authorities/law enforcement within 24 hours of the abuse or neglect becoming known to him or her and must also follow up with a written report to civil authorities within 72 hours, exclusive of weekends and holidays. Many people working or volunteering in a Catholic parish or school, including clergy, are mandated reporters under state law.


