### October Respect Life Month

### **Help Keep Memorial Flowers Secure**



We have observed that artificial flower arrangements—both in pots and those placed over headstones—are being displaced. These arrangements are often costly and, once dislodged, can travel considerable distances, making it difficult to determine their original location.

To help prevent this, we kindly ask that you take the following precautions:

- •For potted arrangements: Please use wire or durable string across the top of the pot and secure it to the pot holder.
- •For over-the-headstone arrangements: Apply tape to the legs that slide over the headstone to help hold them in place. For plastic parts attached to metal holders: Consider wiring them together, as these parts can easily become separated in strong winds.

### SOCIAL CONCERNS MINUTES

September 18, 2025

Opening Prayer – A prayer to the Holy Spirit to help us be prophets of love and servants of reconciliation during these difficult times.

- Guest presenter Bonnie Sandberg spoke on behalf of Elder Network, an organization that serves the needs of the elderly; they are looking for volunteers and staff to carry out their home visits, transportation and other forms of assistance.
- There was a brief report on those who volunteered at Feed My Starving Children; both adults and youth participated in this well-organized event to pack food for the hungry around the world.
- Plans were finalized for Isaac Landsteiner's presentation on the Eucharist and Catholic Social Teaching; it will be in church immediately after 9:30 am Mass, Sunday, September 28, followed by food and fellow-


