Father Tom Loomis Pastor

I had a wonderful time at the retreat I attended in Winona a week ago. The theme of the retreat was Hope and how to live out the Catholic sense of hope in our daily lives as priests. It's not a false hope that we are to live out (head in the sand, rose colored glasses) but a hope centered in Jesus. It is a very timely retreat for me as we get close to the Advent season.

I so appreciated our time together Saturday night at St. Felix. I had a very good sense of community as we gathered. The future is so full of hope for both our worshipping communities. I'm glad we are able to talk and listen to one another.

With the end of the church year next weekend, we will hear Scripture readings that deal with end times, judgement, etc. This weekend we celebrate the Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time and will hear from Luke 21:5-19. Jesus speaks of his followers' suffering persecution. This does not necessarily mean the end is coming. It is a powerful reminder that those who believe in Jesus are aware that persecution seems to be part of having faith. Today we tend to avoid pain and persecution. No one likes to be persecuted and experience pain, but it is a way to witness to someone and something "bigger", the person of Jesus. This week, I ask us to be mindful on how we live our faith when there is adversity and disagreements. Are we willing to speak the truth only Jesus can offer?




