## Ryan Saltness Seminarian

Hello everyone. My name is Ryan Saltness. I'm the seminarian here with St. Felix and St. Agnes for the summer. I'm grateful for Fr. Loomis, the staff, and this parish community for the ways you have made me feel welcome. It has already been incredibly life-giving to be home in southern MN. I'm eager to meet you and excited for all the learning opportunities as this is my first parish assignment as a seminarian. I grew up in the Rochester Catholic Schools system attending St. Francis of Assisi School and Lourdes High School. I had a lot of energy as a kid. To quote one of my grade-school teachers when she found out I joined the seminary, "Ryan, you've come a long way!" Most of my time was spent outside with friends or playing sports. I played hockey and baseball through high school. I'm also grateful to not be far from my family this summer: Rick and Jacque (parents) and Rachel and Renee (sisters).

This Sunday's Gospel continues from last weekend in the 10th chapter of Luke's Gospel (Luke 10:25-37). We are encountering a parable that is perhaps familiar to many of us: the Parable of the Good Samaritan. Everything Jesus says and does presents his followers with a "teaching moment." Last weekend, Jesus' followers learned more about what following Him looks like: going out with a sense of urgency to share the Good News. In this Gospel we learn of another characteristic: a keen attentiveness to those in need. We know this can perhaps take many forms. As Christians we live with a preferential option for the poor, making it our responsibility to share our resources with those in need. We also know a spiritual and moral poverty when we see it. The overtones of healing in this parable are also striking, "he approached the victim, poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them." How might Jesus be a source of healing for others through me? Jesus, increase our attentiveness to those in need. Free us from poverty in all forms.

This year, **Fr. Patrick Arens** is celebrating **25 years of ministry in the priesthood**.

All are invited to join in a special Mass of Thanksgiving that he will offer at St. Agnes on **Sunday, July 27th** at 10:00 AM and brunch that will follow in the hall. Please join in this celebration, giving thanks to God for his vocation which began and was nurtured in the Kellogg and Wabasha faith communities.
