Hospitality in our Scriptures involves offering others peace and comfort, not division and anxiety. A powerful reminder to all of us on how do we welcome others. How is our hospitality a way to offer comfort and peace to our guest? What might hospitality look like at our weekend Masses? Are we willing to introduce ourselves to those who don't know our names? How well do we welcome visitors at Mass? With Jesus all things are possible!


