# Fr. Tom Loomis Pastor

At one time I was assigned to St. Parick's in Lanesboro for six years. Lanesboro is a lot like Wabasha with many visitors during the summer. In the summer the Sunday 8 a.m. Mass was full of people from all over the world. I have had that same experience here in Kellogg and Wabasha. The fact that we have visitors from all over the world at Mass at St. Felix and St. Agnes is uplifting to me. Many stop to introduce themselves to me before or after Mass. They find our communities to be alive and our churches beautiful. There are times where I would love to have visitors come to the front of the church and share their experiences of our worshipping communities here in Wabasha and Kellogg. They seem to see things and experience things that those of us who worship often here take for granted or are not aware of. Next time you see someone at Mass who you don't know, welcome them and be interested in who they are. They might be able to help us invite back those parishioners who were once part of St. Felix and St. Agnes who live only blocks or miles away instead of halfway around the world.

As we gather to celebrate the Eucharist this weekend we hear from Luke 11:11-13. The disciples ask Jesus to help them pray like John's disciples. Jesus teaches them how to pray the "Our Father". After this teaching he talks about being persistent in prayer." Jesus explains that persevering in prayer includes asking for the gift of the Holy Spirit. How much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him? What a powerful reminder to all of us. I find it beautiful that John's disciples' prayer was so attractive to the disciples of Jesus. How did Johns disciples pray? What did it look like? What did their prayer sound like? Is our prayer inspiring and attractive at St. Felix and St. Agnes. Would our celebration of the Eucharist inspire others to seek Jesus? The Holy Spirit is alive. Let's continue to ask for the gift of the Holy Spirit that has already been given to us as a gift.
