A reminder that August 15th is a Holy Day. We celebrate the Assumption of Mary. There will be a Vigil Mass at 6:30 PM Thursday evening, August 14th, at St. Agnes and a Friday morning Mass, August 15th, at 8:00 AM at St. Felix. We will gather as a people to honor Mary and worship the Trinity. Mary, the Mother of Jesus, was one of the first disciples who raised Jesus and stood by him for all the ages. In many ways, she is a reminder of the sacredness of family and our relationships that bring us closer to Jesus through love and respect. What an amazing model for all of us.

On this 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time we will hear from the Gospel of Luke 12:32-48. We hear Jesus tell us that the Father has given you/ us the Kingdom. 
