It's a time get together before school starts to connect and appreciate our roles as people of faith and to learn of new ways, or share old ways of sharing the faith with our youth. A powerful part of the day is celebrating Mass together and sharing ideas around the lunch table. I appreciate all of our teachers and staff at St. Felix and ask for your prayers and support for them during this upcoming school year.

I, along with Ron Zeilinger and Sandra Allaire, will be attending the Synod in Mankato on this upcoming Thursday and Friday. There will be no Mass on Friday, the 22nd. Please pray for the diocese on Thursday and Friday as we gather from all over the diocese to be formed and led by the Holy Spirit. The possibilities are limitless on how we can continue, or deepen how we live out our faith as an individual and as a community.

A very powerful and thought provoking Gospel from Luke 12:49-53 this weekend. Jesus speaks about division in the world and even in our families, not just in the future but even today. These words seem a bit harsh but they are encouraging people who have been rejected because of Jesus to continue to follow him and keep the faith. Perseverance is one powerful point this Gospel from Luke is making. Today's world seems to be at odds, at times, with the teachings of Jesus. Why do you think that is? How do you and I deal with our suffering when it comes to following Jesus, in the world, even in our own families?




