Welcome to all who are joining us this weekend for our Fall Festival at St. Felix. We are glad you are here. Thank you to everyone who has put time and effort into planning for the festival. I am amazed at how much time and energy is put into planning and preparing for such a wonderful event. Like the Watermelon Festival last week, it's a great way to bring our community together.

Wabasha-Kellogg schools were able to start this past week. Being involved with Catholic schools for most of my priesthood I know how difficult it is at times when things don't go as we had planned. We pray for St. Felix School often. I would ask that we intentionally pray for all our children, Catholic school and Public school, their teachers and staff as well, this week. We are a community that desires the very best for our children.

I have been a Spiritual Director at the Seminary for a number of years. Last week was my first day at the seminary as the school year begins. 
