**Father Frerichs  
Weekly Column**

Dear friends in Christ,

It is a joy to be with you again as we begin transitioning into public liturgies and now into the summer months. I am very grateful for the assistance that several people have provided in my transition to the St. Agnes Rectory and for the generous welcome that so many of you have offered during these last several days. It may be appropriate to offer a few words of introduction in this first column for those of us who have not had the opportunity to meet.

I am usually known as Fr. Frerichs, although Fr. Glenn works as well. I grew up in rural central Minnesota, near Little Falls, with one younger brother and one younger sister. Upon obtaining a degree in Industrial Technology from Bemidji State University, I worked in Plano, Texas for about two years. Having experienced a spiritual conversion and a call to the priesthood during this time, seminary formation began in January of 1994. Since my priestly ordination in May of 2000, my ministry has been blessed with service to many wonderful communities around the diocese. Most recently, after having served in the Wabasha-Kellogg area from 2008-2011, I studied canon law in Washington DC. In addition to parish work, I now also serve as the Judicial Vicar and Chancellor for the Diocese of Winona-Rochester.

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, confessing the revelation that God is of one substance, while also existing as a community of persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. As each of us has been drawn into this divine life through baptism, I want to close by sharing how appreciative I am of being able to serve your communities again. May the Triune God bless our communities, both now and in the times to come.

### How God Loves: Scott Hahn Reflects on Trinity Sunday

We often begin Mass with the prayer from today's Epistle: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you." We praise the God who has revealed Himself as a Trinity, a communion of persons.

Communion with the Trinity is the goal of our worship—and the purpose of the salvation history that begins in the Bible and continues in the Eucharist and sacraments of the Church.

We see the beginnings of God's self-revelation in today's First Reading, as He passes before Moses and cries out His holy name. Israel had sinned in worshipping the golden calf (see Exodus 32). But God does not condemn them to perish. Instead, He proclaims His mercy and faithfulness to His covenant.

God loved Israel as His firstborn son among the nations (see Exodus 4:22). Through Israel—heirs of His covenant with Abraham—God planned to reveal Himself as the Father of all nations (see Genesis 22:18).

The memory of God's covenant testing of Abraham—and Abraham's faithful obedience—lies behind today's Gospel.

In commanding Abraham to offer his only beloved son (see Genesis 22:2, 12, 16), God was preparing us for the fullest possible revelation of His love for the world.

As Abraham was willing to offer Isaac, God did not spare His own Son but handed Him over for us all (see Romans 8:32).

In this, He revealed what was only disclosed partially to Moses—that His kindness continues for a thousand generations, that He forgives our sin, and that He takes us back as His very own people (see Deuteronomy 4:20; 9:29).

Jesus humbled himself to die in obedience to God's will. And for this, the Spirit of God raised Him from the dead (see Romans 8:11), and gave Him a name above every name (see Philippians 2:8–10).

This is the name we glorify in today's Responsorial—the name of our Lord, the God who is Love (see 1 John 4:8, 16).
