Father Prince Raja Pastor

Last weekend, Priesthood Sunday, I received your special blessings during three Masses and prayer cards telling me someone is praying for me Rosary, chaplet of Divine Mercy, Eucharistic Adoration, and gift cards etc. Thank you very much for your kind words and generosity towards me. I want to sincerely thank Serra Club members and volunteers who helped to organize Priesthood Sunday. My mother, back in India, is always an inspiration for my Priesthood life as she is scheduled to have hip and knee surgery. Kindly keep her in your prayers too.

In today's Gospel we have the parable of the vineyard and the wicked tenants. Jesus tells this story to his opponents, namely the Chief Priests and the Elders of the people, to show them that even though they are God's chosen people from the beginning, they have forfeited any claim to the new kingdom of God because of their disloyalty and disobedience to him. The purpose of the parable is, as we find it in the gospel of Matthew, to show that the death of Jesus at the hands of his opponents is consistent with the way God's messengers have been treated down the centuries. They were given a vineyard to cultivate but they claimed it as their own and refused not only to give any return to the true owner but murdered his own son who had come to them on behalf of his father.

Two leading thoughts come to our mind after listening to the parable of today. First, we see the infinite goodness, patience and the mercy of God in his dealing with humankind and secondly, the unsounded depth of wickedness and ingratitude to which man can sink. All he asked in return was their cooperation. But they had other plans: they wanted their kingdom on earth. Yet God was patient with them and again and again pardoned their infidelities.

The Gospel concludes with the words that the Kingdom of God will be given to a people that produce the fruits of the Kingdom. The fruits of the Kingdom are the fruits of the Holy Spirit. They are, as Paul tells the Galatians, "Love, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things."

Are you interested in becoming Catholic? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process by which non-baptized candidates are received into the Roman Catholic Church. Baptized members of other Christian denominations who wish to join the Catholic Church are not baptized again, but are received into full communion with the Catholic Church through profession of faith and the sacraments of Penance, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist.

Who is RCIA for?

- 1. People who have never been baptized.
- 2. People who have been baptized in another Christian faith.
- 3. People baptized in the Catholic Church and have never received the Sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
- 4. People who have received the sacraments through the Catholic Church and have spent time away from the practice of their faith.
- 5. Catholic individuals who want to learn more about their Catholic Faith.

Classes will be starting in October and go until Easter. The classes consist of prayer, presentation of topics, videos, discussion, and fellowship. If you are interested, contact Deacon John Hust at (651) 564-0551.


