In just a few days we begin the Church season of Lent. It is a time of reflection on God's unconditional love for us manifested through His son (Jesus) and our response to His gift of new life he promises. I would like to offer a few thoughts about the three pillars of Lent: Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving.

Prayer can be defined as talking with God. It really involves communication, talking, and listening between us and our God. Our prayer shouldn't be only reciting memorized prayer but it should include time reading Scripture (God's Word) and meditating on it. We need to have a place, a time and a plan for at least 15 minutes. God's Word Among Us is a great way to reflect on God's word and his plans for us. I would encourage you to journal what the Lord is saying to you. Go to Adoration on Thursdays at St. Felix, attend Stations of the Cross or attend daily Mass. Those we love we need to spend time with.

Fasting is a tool that helps us discipline our body and mind. Giving up certain foods or beverages leads to self-denial and hopefully a focus on physical and spiritual health for ourselves as well as others. The time we might have spent on eating or relaxing can become an opportunity to pray more or reach out to our neighbor. It might be very helpful to fast from: screen time, gossip, busyness and other ways you spend much of your time. When we give something up it should lead to doing good.

Almsgiving is giving to others in need. It could be food, money, or any other type of service. God has truly given us everything and we are commanded to share and love our neighbor. I am convinced one of the hardest things for us to give is our time. Relationships take time, whether it is your spouse, God or your neighbor. Pray about who it is in your family or neighborhood that you could give time to this Lent. Visit someone in the Nursing Home or visit a neighbor and let them know they are special and loved.

What good would it do to get everything you want and lose you, the real you? What could you ever trade your soul for?"" (Mark 8:34-37, The Message).


