“You are the Light of the World,” these are words Jesus shared with his disciples 2,000 years ago and with us this weekend. Questions we might ask ourselves: “Am I a shining light to those around me?” How do we get this light to shine to the world?

Jesus states in **John 8:12, “I am the Light of the World”** Jesus is the source of spiritual light. We as Catholics believe that at Baptism we enter into a relationship with the Most Holy Trinity and the Church. We become sons and daughters of the Father, Jesus becomes our Savior and Brother and the Holy Spirit (Fire of God’s love) fills our soul and are filled with Divine light. We also become members of the Body of Christ. Each member of the Church must shine the light of Christ in their faith community and world. The more the Body of Christ works together to share the good news and care for those in need, the brighter the Divine light will shine. We live in a world that seems to be growing darker, more violence, increasing drugs, lack of respect for sanctity of human life and attacks on traditional family values to name a few issues. The answer to these issues is found in the person of Jesus Christ the Light of the World.

Soon we will begin the season of Lent, a time to reflect on our relationship with God, with the Church and those communities we are involved with. Is Christ’s light shining through me or is it under a bushel basket (hidden)? Another way of pondering our spiritual life would be, is Christ’s light (Love) growing in me? I would like to share two ways the light of Christ will fill us and shine through us to others. First, to experience spiritual growth we must increase our devotion to a regular prayer life. Spending time being quiet and listening to God at home or taking time to come to church and being present with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Spending time reading God’s Word and reflecting on His message to you. We must also avail ourselves to the Sacraments, especially Confession and Eucharist. The more time we spend with Jesus the more His Light (grace) will fill us.

The second way the Lord’s light will shine through us is mentioned in the first reading from **Isaiah, “Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and the homeless; clothe the naked when you see them. Then your light shall break forth like the dawn and your wound will be quickly healed.”** We are filled with Christ’s light when we reach out to those suffering mentally, physically or spiritually. When we minister to others with Christ’s compassion his light will shine through us. The Light we shine to those in darkness is a gift we receive over and over from Jesus, who is the Light of the World.
