#### Father Prince Raja Pastor

"Do not be afraid." How good it is for someone who is worried to hear those words from Jesus. In the Bible the words "do not be afraid" are used 365 times. Jesus knew we needed to hear those words. "Do not be afraid." Jesus, who was human as well as divine, knew that some of us need to be reminded again and again not to worry. So many times, in the Gospels we hear Jesus asking us not to worry. Three times in today's Gospel we hear Jesus saying, "Do not be afraid." The reason why Jesus tells us these words is that the Heavenly Father has great concern for us all. He knows us well, our person, our wellbeing, our needs. Hence the central theme of today's reading is that we should expel all fear and anxiety from our minds by cherishing an unshakable confidence in the never-failing providence of God.

Who is Jesus? And who are we? These are the two questions we must ask ourselves when we read the gospel for today's liturgy. Who is Jesus? He is the One who speaks to us! "What I tell you in the dark, utter in the light." Jesus is the Word of the Father, he whom the Father begets and conceives eternally in the Spirit of Love! Jesus is this Man, who is also and firstly God, but who is our Mediator with the Father: it is through Jesus and in Jesus that the Father makes us his adoptive sons, heirs with his only Son. Who are we? We are those who speak to the whole world the same Word that we have heard, in Jesus, from the Father! Because if we are adoptive sons of the Father, and heirs with Christ, then we are also, in a certain way, mediators of the Father's Word, the Word that is none other than Jesus himself.

Jesus delicately tells his disciples not to be worried of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. The history of the church is filled with examples where people have stood for Jesus and sacrificed their lives. Today's Gospel reminds us that we do have a responsibility to stand up and be counted. And, thank God, many are still doing so. "If anyone declares himself for me in the presence of others, I will declare myself for him in the presence of my Father in heaven.

#### A Report on St. Felix Parish Council Meeting May 31,2023

- The Social Concerns Committee asked to extend
   Hospitality Sunday to include after Saturday Mass
   – plans will begin to set this up.
- Social Concerns Committee Report: There will be a Chimney Swift event\_Wednesday, August 23, at 8:00 pm in the St. Felix School yard. This is an outgrowth of Pope Francis's encyclical on the environment, "Our Common Home."
- Liturgy Committee Report: Committee members are currently reviewing Church liturgy documents and reviewing St. Felix liturgy practices; the goal is full participation of the people in the liturgy; the baptismal font has been more prominently placed to the left of St. Joseph altar.
- A letter from the Parish Council was approved that invites school and parish organizations and events to eliminate use of plastic/styrofoam eating and serving items.
- The sister parish initiative was reviewed; On August 6th we will provide the parish with information in the school gym after Mass, there will be a pictorial powerpoint and information on the idea of a sister parish in India; the approach to this project depends on parish interest.

During the 2023-2024 academic year, in support of our U.S. Church's Nation Eucharistic Revival, the diocesan **INSTITUTE OF LAY FORMATION** will provide a one-year formation process of intensive study of, and reflection on, the Church's teaching on the Eucharist. With the theme, "Eucharistic Formation for Missionary Discipleship," the aim of this year is to form lay leaders as missionary disciples "who are healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist-and who are then sent out on mission "for the life of the world." Program and registration information are available online at the Institute web page (https://www.dowr.org/offices/lay-formation/Institue.html). This will be a special one-year program of the Institute, and it is open to all interested lay women and men in the diocese.


