In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the sower and the seed to the people gathered on the seashore to listen to him. Let's pray for rain so that farmers will be happy to reach abundant harvest.

The word of God comes gently and is never intended to remain suspended like clouds in mid air, but to soak the earth and to be drawn back toward God after completing its purpose. 
