

John Hampe and Dorothy Arendt have been contacted by Michael Sheehan and Paula Harrigan, concerning the upcoming invitation to the DOW-R Vocation Discernment Events. Paula Harrigan, a fellow Serran, and assistant to Fr. Jason Kern is asking the Serra Club of Wabasha County to promote these upcoming vocational discernment events. There are three conferences planned with the <u>first event</u> to be held at the St. Thomas Moore Newman Center in Mankato on February 24th. It is primarily intended for high school age boys and girls. The <u>second event</u> is being held at Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary "Visitation Days" the weekends of February 24th and March 16th. These weekends are open to young men who are Juniors/Seniors in High School and college age and post college age men. The <u>third</u> <u>event</u> is the "Open Hearts" Conference at St. Mary's University in Winona, co-sponsored by St. Mary's and the Diocese of Winona-Rochester. This event is scheduled for April 13 and open to young women aged 14 years and up into early adulthood.
