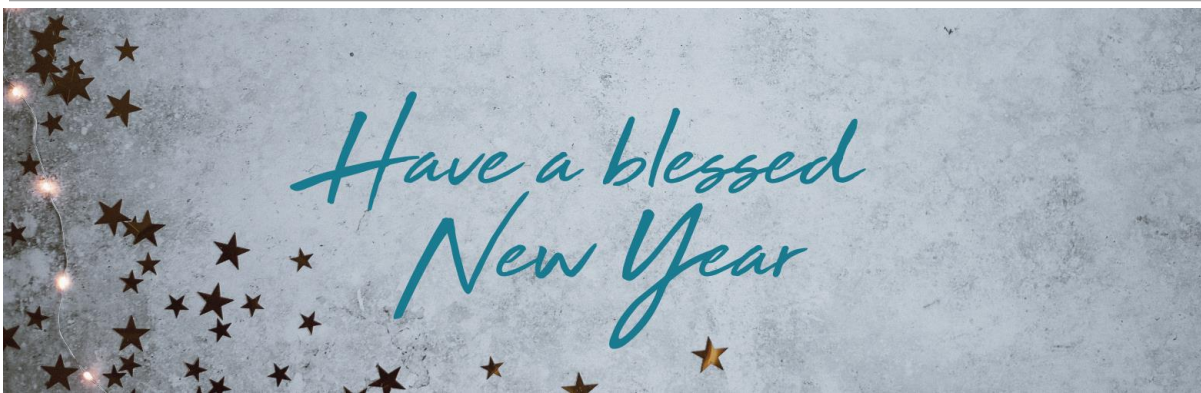




The Holy Father's Intentions for the Month of January, 2020

Fr. Casey, a native of Philadelphia, PA and graduate of Temple University, gave up his Army career in order to study for the priesthood. He entered the Congregation of the Father of Mercy, graduated from Holy Apostles Seminary and has been a member of the community since 1986. He served as the Superior General of his Congregation from 1997-2009. He has worked extensively with St. Joseph Communications since 1995 and has appeared on Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN) since 1999. Fr. Casey attributes his call to the priesthood to the Divine Mercy, his love for the study of Sacred Scripture and his strong devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

During the Mission, he will change the parish community to make a stronger, deeper personal commitment to Christ and His Church. Among the topics he will present during the Mission are the reality of personal sin and the need for sincere conversion and repentance; the biblical and historical foundations of the Mass and the Holy Eucharist; the Blessed Virgin Mary; the power of prayer; the Ten Commandments and the theology of Christ love and morality, and the foundations of the Catholic Church.
