




## **A Choral Holy Hour**

## A REFLECTION on This Week's First Reading

Acts 3:13-19 recounts Peter's sermon following the healing of a lame man at the Beautiful Gate of the temple. In this passage, Peter addresses the crowd, acknowledging their role in Jesus' crucifixion but also offering them hope and calling them to repentance. Here's a reflection on stewardship based on this passage:

#### **Gospel Reflection for next week**

4th Sunday of Easter - John 10:11-18

Don't be fooled next week into thinking that the Gospel is about Shepherds. Too many artists have clouded our thinking about this text. If they really understood what John is proposing, the Shepherd would have nail marks and scars from a thorn crown. This text is about the risen Christ, about his self-understanding and his mission. Therefore, it begins to be about us, or about any who make themselves one with Christ and take up his mission. We do no justice to John's Gospel by reducing these verses to sentimental portraits of pastoral landscapes with soft lighting and lovely clean robes on a man with flowing hair. This Gospel is about the Christ who is no victim. He willingly suffers and lays down his life. He makes choices for the sake of others. This image is not for admiration. It is for imitation. It proposes to us that we make choices for the sake of others, that we lay down our life as a way of rising up. Service, Sacrifice, Love given freely is what we proclaim next week. This is not a story about Jesus, about what he said and did. It is about today and what he continues to do in and through us. It is also about our future and who shall become children of God. It is about the world coming to know him because it comes to know us.



#### THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

It must have been a very awkward moment for Peter. Jesus knew. Peter knew. And Peter knew that Jesus knew. He had denied Jesus after bragging that he was ready to die for him. He was hesitant to let Jesus wash his feet. He had been so stubborn and now felt very foolish. What could Peter say?

Jesus never asks for an explanation. There is no need for one. He reaches out to Peter three times, asking if Peter loved Him, one time for each denial. In entrusting Peter with the task to feed the sheep, Jesus is extending to Peter forgiveness, love and understanding. Peter does not have to ask; Jesus seeks him out and his profession of love as well. God's love seeks us out. He does not wait for us, but moves toward us, prompting our hearts to profess our love and faith in Him. We are never left to find our own way, but are guided and directed by the movement of God within us. Look around and see all the signposts that point the way. Church, sacraments, prayer, family and friends. Do not persist in your fear, but rejoice in God's love! (c) Liturgical Publications line

This year is officially 'The Year of the Holy Spirit' with the Holy Father calling us to focus on the Holy Spirit's sanctifying presence. In response, new prayer groups form and "Life in the Spirit" seminars help parishioners yield to the gifts of the Holy Spirit received at Baptism and reaffirmed at Confirmation. Attendance is up in 1998. Two masses

are added during season to alleviate parking problems—a total of three mass times on Saturday and five mass times on Sunday—and bulletin announcements encourage parishioners to park at Seagate Elementary, Waterside Shops, or at the Education Building rather than on the grass along West Blvd. Weekly music and worship booklets are discontinued and use of the hymnals is reinstated. In April the Education Building is officially renamed the "Ministry Center of St William Parish" to better reflect the growth of the parish and use of the building. Holy Week opens Monday evening (April 6) with Stations of the Cross at 7 PM with readings and music by the children of St William.
