SCHOOL ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

Tuition Payment Agreement

Today the youngest student of each current school family is receiving a Tuition Payment Agreement form (TPA). This is the tuition contract for the 2018-2019 school year. This form is required for all tuition paying families. Families who apply and qualify for the school choice voucher program do not need to complete the TPA. We ask that the TPA be returned by February 28th.

Financial Aid

The Siena School System is also offering Financial Assistance to families, based on need, who did not qualify for the parental choice program. Information is included on the TPA.

Parental Choice Voucher Program

A reminder to families applying for the School Choice program—it is imperative that you apply prior to February 20th! Also, please remember to bring in your verification or income and residency documents after applying. The below information is about the application process.

How the process works:

- 1. The parent or guardian logs into the online parent application. dpi.wi.gov/choice
- **2.** Once logged in, the application will take the parent to an instruction page on how to verify the email address. The parent's instructions read as follows:
- a. You need to verify your email address for the Private School Choice Program Online Application.
- b. Go to the inbox for your email account for: "email address@email.com"
- c. Click the "Confirm Email Address" link in the email to confirm your email address.
- 3. Once the parent clicks the "Confirm Email Address" link in the email, the link will take the parent to the email verification confirmation page where it notifies the parent that their email address has been verified.
- **4.** On the email verification confirmation page, the parent will be instructed to click on a link to return to the online parent application log-in page where the parent will need to enter his or her email and password to continue the application process.
