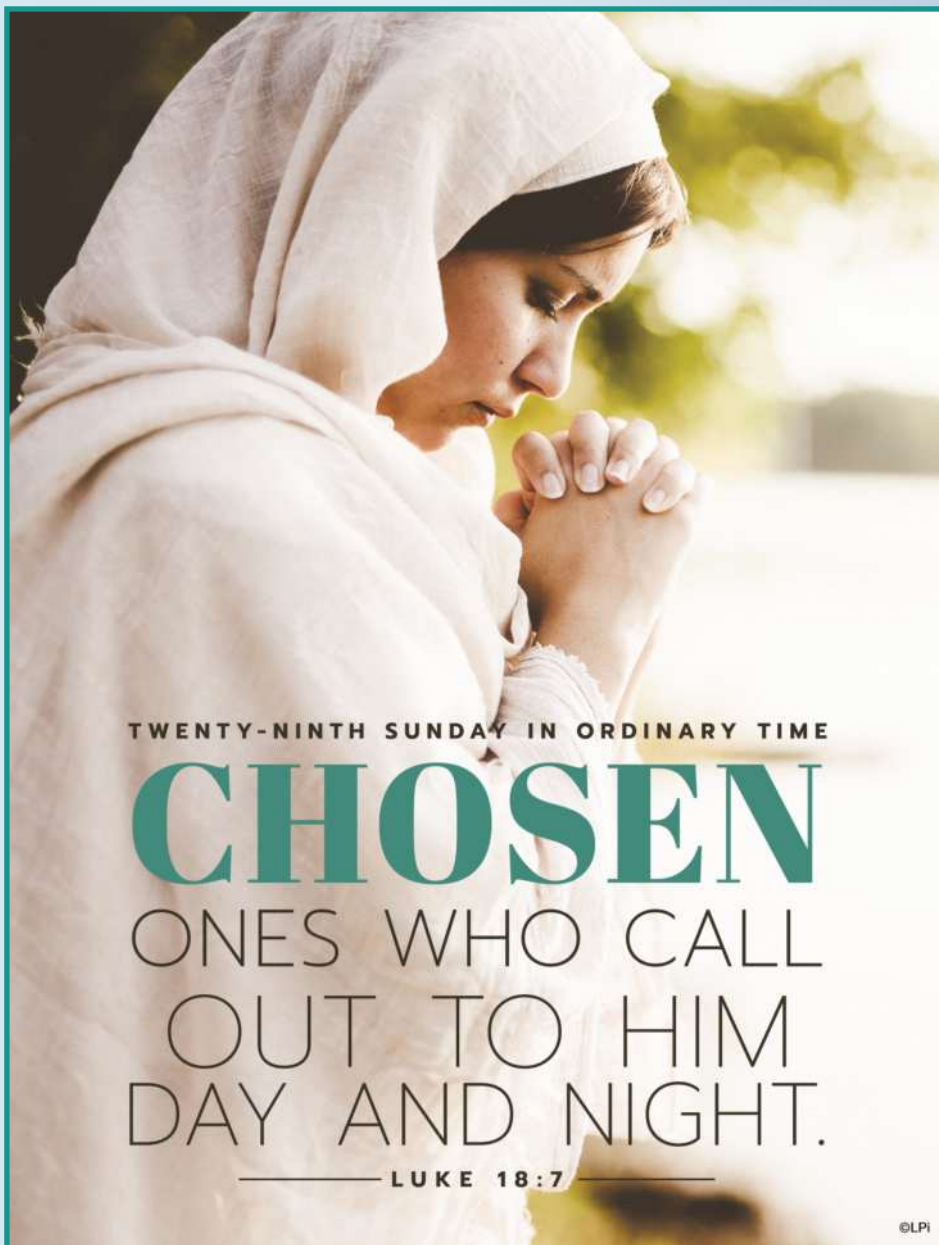

This weekend we are also grateful to celebrate the vocation of Marriage by helping fellow parishioners who are celebrating a milestone wedding anniversary this year. As we mention them in prayer this weekend, don't forget to congratulate them for helping model for us this beautiful vocation.

As of this writing I am still working on the fall training schedule for our liturgical ministers of Reader or Altar Server as promised in the bulletins. That will be communicated via email. Again, if you are a high school student interested in becoming an emcee altar server (grades 10-12) or an altar server in grades (4-9); or in becoming a Lector (after you make your First Communion) please let me know by reaching out to me at the Office or via email. This is a great opportunity to get involved. Also, a reminder that in November we will begin offering in the presider's line the low-gluten host option. All you will have to do is let me (or the substitute priest) know you need one when you come forward for Holy Communion.

A reminder that as we have brought back the opportunity for Daily Mass (Monday, Wednesday, Friday @ 7:30 am; Tuesday, Thursday @ 8:30 am), these masses are also livestreamed via YouTube (and Facebook) if your schedule does not allow you to join in person. You can either join LIVE or ARCHIVED from earlier in the day. They are linked to our Facebook page as well. Please note the following:

- o Thursday is not livestreamed.
- o The schedule is published in our bulletin and on our website under "Mass Intention Calendar". (In the rare emergency of cancellation that is not published previously, that information will be communicated via email, myparishapp, and if possible, a sign on the door.)
- o Please mark your calendars for the week of November 7-13 as we will have available an exhibit on the Shroud of Jesus. More information will be released via email soon! Also, before both Sunday Masses next weekend we will have the opportunity of praying the Rosary before Mass. Although we are not able to do this before all Masses every Sunday we are heeding our Blessed Mother's (and Pope Leo's) advice to pray the Rosary for Peace this month. Please join us and offer your own throughout the week!

The Feast of St. John Paul II – On October 22nd, we
celebrate the pope who inspired the world! Born Karol
Wojtyla in Krakow, Pope John Paul II became the first-
ever Polish pope. He came of age in the early 20th century
and lived through both the Nazi and communist
occupations of Poland. His resistance activities were
cultural, operating an underground theater company and
entering a secret seminary. Karol was ordained a priest in
1946 and later a bishop. He was elected pope in 1978. As
pope, the interests that captured his heart as a young man
continued — his pastoral concern for young people, his
philosophical emphasis on the human person, and his
devotion to Mary and to the mercy of God.
