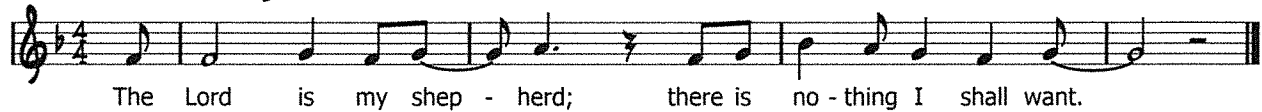
Behold the wood that bears our name; behold the nails that hold our sin.
