TADS TUITION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

We use the TADS online tuition management system for our enrollment and payments. Payment options are 1, 2, or 10 installments.

GUARDIAN ANGEL TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Through the generosity of school families, parish members, and those in our community and beyond, we have a tuition assistance program available to help families who otherwise might not be able to afford all tuition costs. Guardian Angel Program applications are available online and in the school office. All information is confidential and applications are reviewed by the Parish Finance Council.

TUITION REDUCTION PROGRAM

SCRIP Program: available for purchase on line or after weekend masses. 70% of rebates can be used to reduce the cost of next year's tuition.

APPLE PIE SALE

Our apple pie sale is one of only 2 major fundraisers we do each year. The sale has grown and surpassed all expectations over the years. This past October, we were able to raise \$38,000 to help fund the school and its programs! This event takes place over two days in October and each family is asked to work three, 3 hour shifts, and encouraged to sell 18 pies each. The sale not only brings in much needed funds, but also serves as a family and community bonding activity.

DINNER AUCTION/GRAPES & GRAINS EVENT

The dinner auction is a semi-formal evening featuring a dinner, silent auction, live auction, raffles, and entertainment. On alternate years, the Grapes & Grains event takes place which is a more casual evening of wine and beer tasting. The event also features a silent auction and entertainment.

V-TIME/FAMILY VOLUNTEER TIME

Volunteering not only teaches our children the value of giving back to the community and using our God given talents to the fullest, volunteering allows us to continue to offer many of the extra programs, enhancements, and events here at St. Boniface School.
