Lenten Fasting and Abstinence Practices

In addition to choosing our own practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, Catholics are asked to observe the following practices of fasting and abstinence during the 40 Days of Lent:

1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent, in addition to Good Friday.
2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. The fasting practice stipulates consuming only one full meal that day. Two small snacks, sufficient to maintain strength according to one's needs, may also be eaten, but these two snacks together should not equal the amount of another full meal. Eating outside of the one full meal and two snacks is not permitted, though liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
3. Because of the penitential nature of these practices and our own recognition of our sinfulness and need of salvation, Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these minimal practices of fasting and abstinence.
