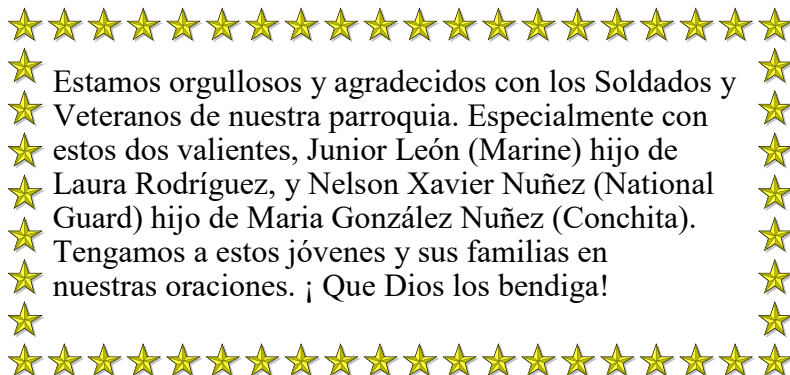

.This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday.

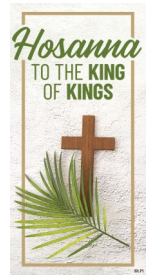
Father Francis Fernandez writes in his series, In Conversation with God,

Hoy celebramos el Domingo de Ramos.

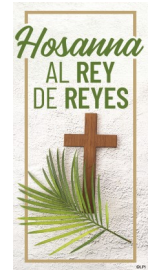
El Padre Francisco Fernández escribe en su libro Hablar con Dios,

VIVIR LA LITURGIA - INSPIRACIÓN DE LA SEMANA (Live the Liturgy)

Aclamado un momento y rechazado el siguiente. Este parece ser el patrón que se repite no solo a lo largo de la historia, sino también en nuestras propias vidas. ¡Jesús quiere ser recibido triunfalmente, en nuestro corazón, con gozo! ¡Y le damos la bienvenida! Luego llegan los momentos en que hacemos exactamente lo contrario y rechazamos las enseñanzas del Evangelio

y damos la espalda a la amistad de Dios. El que alguna vez fue amigo, ahora se convierte en enemigo. Jesús comprende nuestra ambivalencia. Lo vivió camino a la cruz. Comprendiendo toda la gama de emociones humanas, Dios nos acepta donde estamos. Hay mucho drama en el camino al Calvario. Nuestras vidas pueden ser dramáticas también. En todos esos momentos de torbellino, puede ser difícil encontrar la presencia de Dios y comprender su voluntad. Caminamos con Jesús esta semana buscando inspiración y esperanza, las llaves esenciales necesarias para abrir la puerta a la presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas.

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Hailed one moment and rejected the next. This seems to be the pattern that repeats itself not only throughout history but in our own lives as well. Jesus wants to be triumphantly welcomed into our hearts with joy! And welcome him we do! Then come the times when we do exactly the opposite and we reject the teachings of the Gospel and turn our backs on God's friendship. The one who at one time is a friend now becomes an enemy. Jesus understands our ambivalence. He lived it on the way to the cross. Understanding the full array of human emotion, God accepts us where we are. There is a great deal of drama on the road to Calvary. Our lives can be dramatic as well. In all of those whirlwind moments it can be difficult to find God's presence and understand his will. We walk with Jesus this week seeking inspiration and hope, the essential keys needed to unlock the door to God's presence in our lives.

Santa Bernardita Soubirous 16 de abril

A la edad de 14 años, Santa Bernadette (1844-1879) vivía en la más absoluta pobreza con su familia en un sótano de una habitación que anteriormente había sido utilizado como cárcel, en la ciudad de Lourdes, en el sur de Francia. Ella era una niña enfermiza, fue víctima del cólera en 1854 y lucharía contra el asma y la tuberculosis por el resto de su corta vida. Bernadette era analfabeta y en muchos relatos se le caracteriza como lenta o ignorante. Cuando tenía 14 años, a Bernadette se le concedieron 18 visiones de una 'Señora' en una gruta en Massabielle. La Señora instruyó a Bernadette para que viniera todos los días a la gruta para recibir las visiones, y finalmente proclamó "Yo soy la Inmaculada Concepción". Un manantial en la gruta, que apareció donde Bernadette recibió instrucciones de cavar, ha sido un sitio de curación milagrosa. La Señora también pidió que se construyera una capilla en la gruta para los peregrinos. Hoy, el Santuario Mariano de Lourdes es uno de los más populares del mundo.

Durante y después del período de visiones, la santa fue examinada rigurosamente por la Iglesia y las autoridades locales. El entusiasmo popular en torno a las visiones la dejó sujeta a constantes preguntas y atención. Eventualmente buscó protección retirándose a un hogar para los pobres en un convento. Hizo sus votos en 1866 con las Hermanas de la Caridad en Nevers. Trabajó como asistente de enfermería y luego como sacristán, pero al final de su vida estaba demasiado enferma para participar en la vida del convento. Murió a la edad de 35 años, humilde y penitente hasta el final.

St. Bernadette Soubirous April 16

At the age of 14 St. Bernadette (1844-1879) was living in abject poverty with her family in a one-room basement which had previously been used as a jail, in the town of Lourdes in southern France. She was a sickly child, having fallen victim to Cholera in 1854 and would battle asthma and tuberculosis for the rest of her short life. Bernadette was illiterate and is characterized in many accounts as slow or ignorant. It was in her 14th year that Bernadette was granted 18 visions of a 'Lady' at a grotto in Massabielle. The Lady instructed Bernadette to come daily to the grotto to receive the visions, eventually proclaiming 'I am the Immaculate Conception'. A spring at the grotto, which appeared where Bernadette was instructed to dig, has been a site of miraculous healing. The Lady also asked that a chapel be built in the grotto for pilgrims. Today the Marian Shrine at Lourdes is one of the world's most popular.

During and following the period of visions, the saint was examined rigorously by Church and local authorities. The popular excitement around the visions left her subject to persistent questioning and attention. Eventually she sought protection by retiring to a home for the poor in a nunnery. She took her vows in 1866 with the Sisters of Charity at Nevers. She worked as an infirmiry assistant, and later a sacristan, but by the end of her life she was too sick to participate in convent life. She died at the age of 35, humble and penitent until the end.

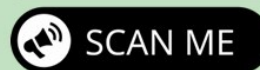
