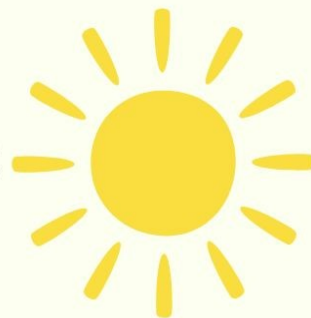

FRANCISCAN MISSIONARY SISTERS OF YOUTH (FMSY)

The Community of Franciscan Missionary Sisters of Youth (HMFJ/FMSY) was founded in Quito, Ecuador - South America, on July 4, 1982 by Mons. Fausto Trávez, ofm.

The **HMFJ/FMSY** were born as a response to the preferential option of the Latin American Church: to give one's life for the poor and young (Puebla 1979: n° 1186).

CHARISM, MISSION

As Missionaries, we have only one word to say: **GOD**, to carry out the revolution of Love and Tenderness, as Pope Francis tells us. We carry the sign of the Tau that identifies us as Franciscan nuns.

Following the example of Holy Mary, we are women consecrated to God, promoting community and apostolic life, living the evangelical counsels of poverty, obedience and chastity and assuming the mission of "giving Jesus to the world".

Faithful to the Franciscan charism and spirituality, we live our vocation, following the example of Saint Francis and Saint Clare of Assisi, following in the footsteps of Jesus, Poor and Crucified, at the service of the poorest in society: children, adolescents, youth and families according to the context and needs of each region.

All this in unity and **fidelity to the Church and its directives**; we actively cooperate in evangelizing Mission, in accordance with our own charism, at the service of the local Church.

We carry out our **apostolic mission** in a vital synthesis of prayer and action. Moved by the profound desire to live each day with their own Charism and the Mission of the Community.

The community offers **training and formation spaces** that respond to the demands of current times and that, starting from a constant, dynamic and procedural evangelization, allow children, adolescents, young people and adults to be leavened and find their place in the Church and society through:

- Arts workshops:
- Formation workshops and spiritual retreats.
- Programs to help children, adolescents and young people.
- Academic recovery programs.
- Parish catechesis and summer camps.
- Communal pantries/Food Pantry.
- Parish ministry.
- Psychological, emotional and spiritual.
- Accommodation and food for low-income.
- Missions in strong times of the church.
- Social assistance.
- Volunteering.

FINANCING

Our mission and ministry in Ecuador is carried out with people of medium and limited resources. To financially pay for the acquisition of materials, have trained personnel for the formation programs of the sisters, children and young people: we make clerical clothing, we sell prepared food, we sow and harvest

local products. However, it is not enough, given the realities that Latin American countries like ours are suffering, and even more so after the pandemic. That is why we come to you and present two projects that need your generous contribute

1. PASTORAL ACTION CENTER "RIVOTORTO" – Vacation Course "Building Hope"

School dropout in vulnerable sectors is not only an educational problem but also a social and spiritual one. Many children and adolescents abandon their studies due to a lack of academic support, low self-esteem, or little motivation. Inspired by the Franciscan charism and the pastoral commitment of the universal Church, this project emerges to accompany, support, and motivate young people by integrating guided tasks, academic leveling, artistic activities, and formation in Christian values. In the province of Cotopaxi, there is a high rate of child malnutrition; with proper guidance and nutritional education, diseases can be prevented, and adequate performance can be strengthened. Our goal is to provide person-centered education, encouraging student participation, constant dialogue, critical reflection, and meaningful learning. The beneficiaries of this project are children, adolescents, and youth between the ages of 5 and 17.

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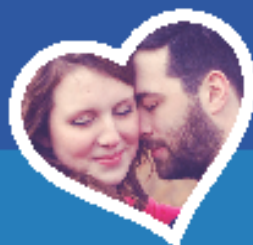
