





I would like to begin this week's newsletter by quoting the honorable Dr. Martin Luther King Jr:

"Returning violence for violence multiplies violence, adding a deeper darkness to a night, already devoid of stars.

Darkness cannot drive out darkness: only love can do that.

Hate cannot drive out hate:
Only love can do that."

I choose this quote not just because we spend this month honoring and celebrating influential Black people in America's history and culture, but for another reason.

The last few weeks it has been quite a revolving door in my office. The number of infractions and disciplinary actions is steadily increasing from K3-8th grade. A great deal of these infractions involve bullying, name calling, profanity, sexually inappropriate language or gestures, and physical aggression. Each day we discuss aspects of kindness, what we can do to be kinder, and that we never put our hands on one another in an aggressive manner. However, I always say it takes a village. I ask that each one of you talk about the seriousness of these behaviors. MGC does not tolerate play fighting, punching, kicking, pushing, swearing, name calling, threats, intimidation or bullying. We believe that conflicts can be worked out by approaching others with compassion, understanding, humility, and empathy. We believe students can learn the skills to talk it out with one another, and if students follow the rules, we can keep our learning environment safe. I would like to remind families that fighting for any reason goes against MGC's Catholic values. Our policy states that verbal and physical altercations will be met with out of school suspension or expulsion. I am seeing many students are being exposed to music, videos, and video games full of violence and sexually explicit material. These can be powerful influences on our youth. Children often absorb and mimic behaviors they see, and the staff is seeing this happening at school. MGC also does not allow inappropriate sexually explicit dancing, or slang of an inappropriate nature. Each child has a right to a safe education in a loving environment. I would encourage parents to carefully monitor screen times and monitor social media formats. I appreciate your support and attention to this matter. Let's encourage love over hate, peace over violence, and light over darkness.

It's Cold Outside – and it will get even colder!

Please remember that we do take the children outside for recess during winter. If the temperature/wind chill is at or above zero, we go outside. It is important that every MGC student come to school every day prepared for recess. This includes a winter coat, hat, mittens/gloves, scarves, snowpants, and boots. Children who do not have snow pants and boots are not allowed to play in the snow. Please do not put your child in that situation!



Weather Regulations



When there is a question of whether the school will be opening for the day because of extreme weather conditions, Archdiocesan regulations require that the school follow the Milwaukee Public School system. The decision not to open is usually made before 6:00 AM on the day in question and is announced on local radio and TV stations. If the announcement is made that MPS schools are closed due to inclement weather, MGC will also be closed.

Whenever the school is closed due to inclement weather, ECP and the parish offices are also closed. However, if MPS is not in session, or for some reason fails to close, an independent decision will be made for MGC. This decision will be made by Mrs. Johnston and Fr. Reed. The announcement will be made on local television and radio stations. Additionally, if MGC closes independently of MPS, an email and text will be sent and local TV/radio stations will be informed.

MGC will not close early due to inclement weather. However, parents are welcome to school and pick up their children if they deem that to be in their family's best interest.

If MPS closes early or fails to open due to staffing concerns, that will not affect MGC.
