





The Lenten Season continues through sundown on Holy Thursday, 3/28. Students this week are working in class on their Lenten projects and learning the Stations of the Cross with their buddy classes. It is wonderful to see them engage in these faith filled activities that bring us closer to God.

As we move forward in the school year, it is essential that we meet our learning goals and standards. The end of the trimester was March 7, and report cards will be coming out by next week. I remind all parents that once you receive your report card electronically, please email or send a message to your child's teacher to confirm. Please carefully review the report cards. A 3 on the standard is our goal says that your child has demonstrated the ability to reach complete understanding and proficiency on the standard. A 2 indicates that the student has not yet reached the standard and there is still work to be done to develop proficiency. A 1 is a score that requires your attention. A 1 in many standards could affect a child's grade placement. This score communicates that the student is unable to provide evidence of or demonstrate proficiency on the learning standard. This is an important report card because for those struggling it may be time to begin thinking about enrolling in summer school programs or providing intervention. As always, I encourage you to reach out to your child's teacher if you have questions and that you work together to provide a network of support at school and home in order to reach learning goals. With a new trimester, comes a new start.

We are also preparing for the Forward Exam for the State of Wisconsin for grades 3-8. This will begin next week for some grades. In order for our students to perform at their best, they need plenty of rest and focus. Students have been practicing in class with their teacher to help prepare.

Furthermore, please check your child's absences and tardies recorded on your child's report card.. If students are absent over 10 days or have more than 5 tardies, it can also affect their future enrollment or grade promotion. I will be putting a hold on next year's enrollment for daily, excessive tardies and truancies until improvement in attendance occurs.. Students are expected to arrive each morning by 7:50a.m. You can expect to see letters concerning tardiness and absences coming out in the next two weeks. Any absences over 10 is considered truant by the State of Wisconsin and is recorded on your child's school record. It will also be reported to the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program which could affect your child's eligibility in the program. Please be mindful of attendance.

I am seeing way too many pick-up's and drop-off's on 68th Street at the end of the day causing traffic jams and unsafe environments. Yesterday, there was a serious accident at the intersection of 68th Street and Lisbon. Unless you are picking up from ECP, cars should enter the gate from Burleigh, and exit onto 68th Street. Keep in mind there is no crossing guard or stopping traffic on that street. Furthermore, especially, students in grades 5-8, we are seeing them trying to leave

the gate before the arrival of their pick-up. For many safety reasons, this cannot continue. Students need to stay inside the gate. If a student walks home, he or she may leave, but for pick-ups, those students need to wait for the arrival of the parent. As I have said many times before, convenience and saving time are not excuses for any of us to take safety risks with our children. I ask that we all work together to follow the procedures put in place to keep our kids safe.
