

Confirmation Service Hours

Remember:

- ◇ **Service is based on the spiritual and corporal works of mercy and most of all on the example of Christ who came to SERVE.**
- ◇ Your service is not a job to be done. Nor is it something you would tag onto a requirement as a member of another organization such as concession stands, Booster Club, Show Choir. Your service hours are selflessly and lovingly helping those in need.
- ◇ You should reflect on how your service project is helping you take on the mind and heart of Christ, fulfill the needs of others, and build up the Christian community.
- ◇ 8th grade year May (end of 7th grade) through April (8th grade): 3 hours church; 3 hours community
 - Hours for 8th grade year to be turned in at last class in April
- ◇ 9th grade year May (end of 8th grade) through April (9th grade): 3 hours church; 3 hours community
 - Hours for 9th grade year to be turned in at last class in April
- ◇ 10th grade year May (end of 9th grade) through April (10th grade): 3 hours church; 3 hours community
 - Hours for 10th grade year to be turned in at last class in April
