Generous scholarships are provided through the Children's Scholarship Fund of Pennsylvania and other assistance is funded through the Erie Diocese and through the Knights of Columbus.

Uniling

At Immaculate Conception Parish School we unite our school family and our community. Students visit the Clarion Free Library weekly (as long as it is safe to do so). The students also donate artwork to local nursing homes. Each student is sorted into a prayer house. They will remain in their prayer house for their entire time at ICPS. The prayer houses do special projects together, attend Mass and form special bonds.



Most importantly we ignite the love of learning in our students. Our program is fully accredited by the Middle States Association Commission on Elementary Schools and exceeds states requirements. Support teachers are provided through Act 89 and Title I services and are available for students who need help in math, reading and speech/language. Students also attend Mass on a weekly basis and have daily religion classes to help instill their relationship with God.
