# **JEWELRY**

JEWELRY: pierced earrings are permitted for girls ONLY. Earrings not permitted to 'dangle' below the earlobe; hoop earings are not permitted, no matter the size. Other body piercing is not permitted, such as but not limited to, eyebrows, nose, or tongue.

**MAKE-UP:** The wearing of makeup is **not permitted,** with the exception of lip gloss for girls.

# DRESS CODE "R"

Jeans and t-shirts may be worn.

The following items are NOT

PERMITTED: 'off the shoulder' shirts, tank tops, sleeveless tops, crop tops, oversize shirts, torn jeans, mini-skirts, short shorts, or anything vulgar, offensive, or provocative.

All t-shirts must be tucked in completely and all clothing must be of modest length.

# METHOD OF ENFORCEMENT

#### **ALL GRADES**

#### **Method of enforcement**

First Offense: Verbal conference with student

Second Offense: Parents/guardians are notified. Notification is sent home and required to be returned next day signed by parent/guardian


Third Offense: Conference with parent/guardian requested

## **GRADES K-3**

#### **GIRLS AND BOYS**

#### **TOPS:** must be tucked in completely

Golf-style Shirt (long or short sleeved)-solid white, navy or light blue.

Turtleneck-solid white or navy

<u>Dress Shirt or Blouse</u> (with collar, button-down the front)-solid white or blue chambray fabric only

<u>Sweaters and Sweatshirts:</u> solid white, or solid navy or school spirit sweatshirt purchased through spirit clothing sale

# **BOTTOMS:** <u>nothing excessively baggy or</u> low-slung permitted

Slacks (dressy, no jeans)-solid navy or khaki Shorts-Only to be worn during warm weather months and NOT PERMITTED ON MASS DAYS (walking style, no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)-solid navy or khaki

#### **Additional Options for Girls:**

<u>Dress</u> navy, light blue or khaki with collar <u>Skirt</u> (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)-solid navy, khaki, or *French Toast* blue/gold plaid

Skort (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) -solid navy, khaki, or *French Toast* blue/gold plaid

Jumper (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)-solid navy, khaki, or *French Toast* blue/gold plaid

<u>Leggings/Tights/Socks:</u> White, tan, khaki, or navy blue ONLY

**HAIR:** no "outlandish" styles or colors Boys: hair no longer than the bottom of the shirt collar

### **GRADES 4-6**

#### **GIRLS AND BOYS**

#### **TOPS:** <u>must be tucked in completely</u>

Golf-style Shirt (long or short sleeved)-solid white, light blue or navy

Turtleneck-solid white or navy

<u>Dress Shirt or Blouse</u> (with collar, buttondown the front)-solid white or blue chambray fabric only

<u>Sweaters, Sweatshirts, Hoodies:</u> solid white, solid navy or school spirit sweatshirt purchased through spirit clothing sale

\*No other jackets/hoodies permitted through the day.

# BOTTOMS: <u>nothing excessively baggy or low-slung permitted.</u>

Slacks (no jeans) solid navy or khaki
Shorts-Only to be worn during warm weather
months and NOT PERMITTED ON MASS
DAYS (walking style, no shorter than 2
inches above the knee)-solid navy or khaki.

\*Belts must be worn by both boys and girls on pants with belt loops\*

#### **Additional Options for Girls:**

<u>Dress</u> navy, light blue or khaki with collar <u>Skirt</u> (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) -solid navy, khaki, or *French Toast* blue/gold plaid

Skort (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) -solid navy, khaki, or *French Toast* blue/gold plaid

Jumper (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee)-solid navy, khaki, or *French Toast* blue/gold plaid

<u>Leggings/Tights/Socks:</u> White, tan, khaki or navy blue ONLY.

**HAIR:** no "outlandish" styles or colors Boys: hair longer than the bottom of the shirt collar

# **GYM CLOTHING**

ONLY spirit clothing purchased through the school Spirit wear sale is permitted, i.e. sweatshirts, shorts, and t-shirts. Solid navy sweatpants are permitted. These items may also be worn any day except on Mass days.

\*GRADES K-4 ARE PERMITTED TO WEAR DRESS CODE CLOTHING INSTEAD OF SPIRIT CLOTHING.

## **GRADES PK-6**

shorts are NOT permitted to be worn to school from October 15 to April 15. This includes gym class days, which are Tuesdays. Students may wear shorts during gym class only. Students may either change before and after gym class, or preferably wear sweat pants over top for ease of changing. However, shorts may NOT be worn all day.

**SHOES:** no flip flops, open back shoes or Crocs permitted.

## FIELD TRIP ATTIRE

#### **BOYS AND GIRLS-ALL GRADES:**

Teacher discretion dependent upon field trip location.
