

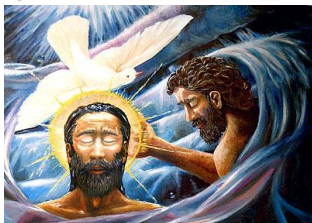

Prior to independence, this soup was only consumed by the elite. Now it is everyone's soup. Due to the present food and water shortages, this was likely a smaller celebration. We pray for peace in Haiti, for the expansion of ongoing repairs to homes and communities severely impacted by the August 2021 earthquake, and for the leadership of small Haitian groups working to provide health care and stability to families.
