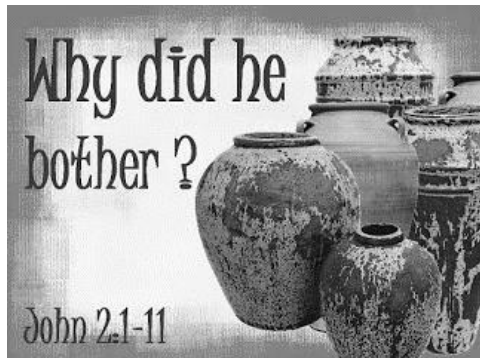



GriefShare includes thirteen weekly video seminars featuring some of the nation's foremost experts on grief recovery topics. Each video is followed by a small group discussion, personal, workbook-guided reflections, and opportunities for encouragement and support as participants walk the journey of grief with others who have lost a loved one. If you participated in the fall seminar you are encouraged to return, as you heal, you will become newly aware of different aspects of the experience in the video series.

A NEW MINISTRY OF CARE FOR THE HOMEBOUND. As members of the body of Christ, we are charged with serving all our members whether they are in the church building or not.
