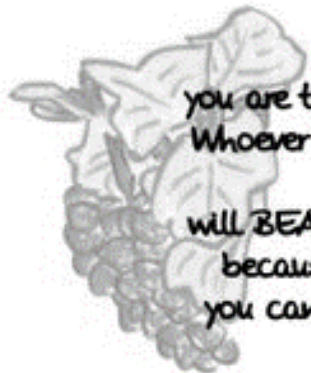

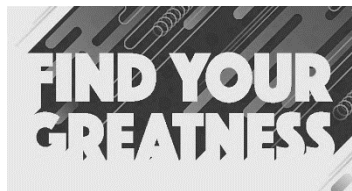

Infant immunization protects people from vaccine-preventable diseases throughout their life. Parents are encouraged or reminded to have their children immunized by the age of 2. If infants are not immunized the consequences can be severe. Disease often brings economic and social costs, misspent time and resources visiting doctors, hospitalizations and poor child and educational development. These consequences are in addition to any of the direct physical symptoms and problems associated with a given condition.
