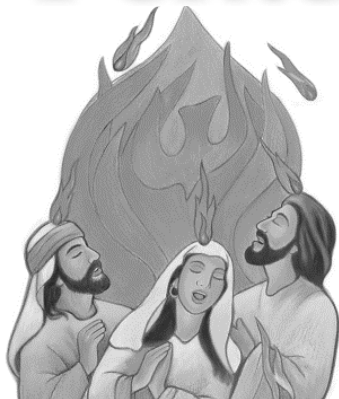

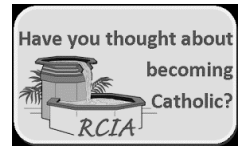

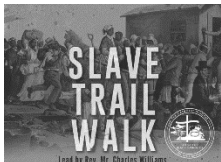

CATECHUMENATE FOR THE PARISH – FOUNDATION OF MINISTRY begins on Monday, June 17 at 7:00 PM in the O'Brien Family Room; and again on Tuesday afternoons beginning June 18. You are invited to attend any or all of these gatherings. Session One will explore evangelization and the vision and development of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. We will view videos on "The Role of Liturgy and Catechesis in the Process of Initiation," and "The Process of Initiation for the Unbaptized." Session Two will focus on "For Whom Is the RCIA Intended." 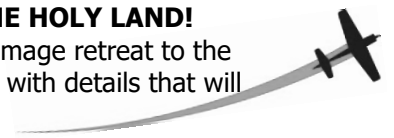
