**HAITI MINISTRY.** Did you know? St. John the Evangelist Parish and St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Staunton provide aid to St. Louis King of France Parish in Haiti. Each parish has a designated area of assistance. We provide a home and sustenance to the aged and infirm with no family to care for them as well as a daily feeding program for 50 people. St. Francis aids with a school, including a daily meal for each child, and a clinic. While the two ministries and goals are separate, committee members share information on current events in the Haitian community to keep benefactors current.
