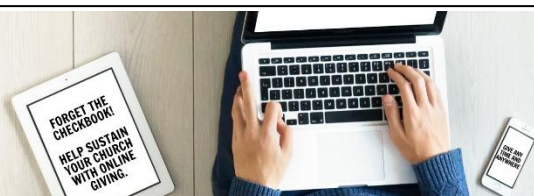

Chesterton Academy of St. Michael the Defender



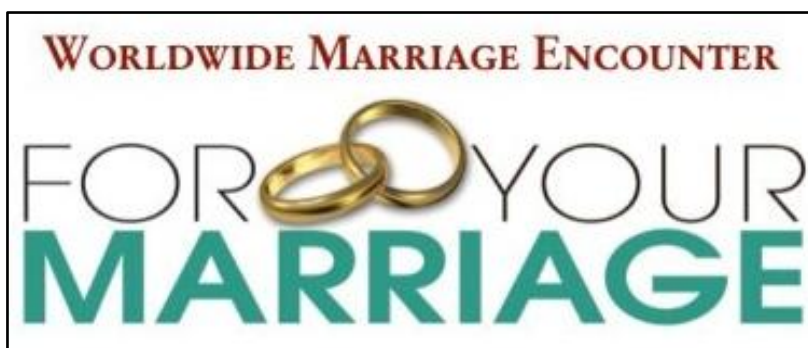
Greetings Friends,
