



HAITI MINISTRY

We continue to provide meals to indigent and infirm seniors at St. Anthony House in the parish of St. Louis King of France on the island of LaGonave, Haiti. Meals consist of beans and rice with spices and are prepared by a cook and her assistant. Some hot meals are delivered by foot to a few living nearby. Several families receive a monthly stipend of beans, rice, oil and spices. Recipients are determined by a parish committee and Fr. Augustin. In all, we assist about 70 persons daily. 
