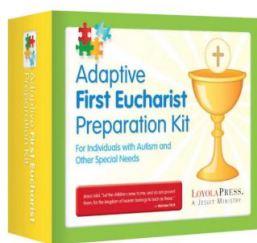

## Join Us for the ECO Pilgrimage – Pilgrims of Hope Date/Time: Sunday, September 28, 2025 at 2:00 PM Location: South River Greenway Trail



We are excited to announce an ECO pilgrimage is being planned by St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church. It will take place on Sunday, Sept. 28, at the South River Greenway Trail.

While for Catholics the walk is part of the Jubilee Year Pilgrims of Hope for Creation initiative, this is an ecumenical pilgrimage bringing together our whole community.

We will begin at Loth Springs Parking area on Arch Avenue, behind the YMCA (parking is available at the library). Then proceed along the 2-mile paved path to North Park, north of downtown, making a total of six stops for a prayer at each.

You may walk all or only some of it with us. The trail is flat and paved for its entirety. At North Park, pilgrims may make the 2-mile return back to the starting point or arrange their own transportation for pick-up.

We invite everyone to walk and pray with us so that we may deepen our faith as we contemplate together our call to protect and care for all of God's creation.
