

ENTRANCE HYMN: O GOD, HOW MANIFEST ARE YOUR WORKS




RESPONSORIAL PSALM: PSALM 118 SETTING BY S. SOPER


PREPARATION OF THE ALTAR: SHEPHERD OF MY HEART
