Dear Parents,

I hope all of you have had a relaxing summer. Time has flown for all of us. But it's that time of year again. PSR will be starting on August 19th this year. We will start the year with regular class. Prayer begins at 6:45 in the gym and then children will proceed to their respective classrooms. This year we will be starting each week in the gym at 6:45. If there is a special occasion on which we start in church, a note will be sent home to that effect.

We will continue to be attending Mass on the first Sunday of each month this year. At 10:15 AM the students will meet their teachers in the back of church. The students are more than welcome to sit with their families **BUT they must first check in with their teachers.** The following Wednesday we will not have class. All other weeks of the month class will be held on Wednesday evenings. This should be taken seriously and understand that the first Sunday of the month is an obligation for the PSR students. If a student is sick or has a legitimate reason for missing, a note or phone call from the parent is expected. No student should miss more than two Sundays even with an excuse. Thank you for your help in this matter.

Enclosed with this letter is a registration form and a calendar for the year. If you have more than one child, each should fill out an individual form. **IMPORTANT: If you are registering for the first time, please enclose a copy of your child's baptismal certificate.** They can be dropped off at the office. If you have a first grader and need another form (one form per child), they are available at the office also. Even if you do not pay the fees at this time, please fill out and drop the registration forms as soon as possible.

If you know of a family who has a first grader and they are not aware of PSR, please inform them and have them call the office. We appreciate your help in this.

We are aware that as parents you are the primary educators for your children. Thank you for allowing us to share in the faith formation of your child/ren.
