2. Pastor's Comments – The Pastoral Center has conducted a vitality study of the parishes in our diocese. The results reflect a strong vitality here.
3. Worship and Spiritual Life Committee – Lent and Holy Week liturgies and church services went very well. Good participation and positive feedback received.
4. Evangelization and Catechesis – Peter Roufs reported the Grandparent's Day went well. The last week of school is going well. Kindergarten Graduation went well, the seniors graduate Sunday and a math teacher is needed. Msgr. Lozinski plans to have all the councils in the AFC meet together to view Peter Herbeck's talk from the Bishop Lucker Lecture. Totus Tuus, a summer catechesis for our youth will take place in June.
