1. Call to Order - Present: Msgr. Lozinski, Terry Helget, Mary Krambeer, Andrea Boyle, Mary Portner, Peter Roufs, Sean Connolly, Jared Miller. Absent: Chris Heiderscheidt, Mark Schwartz, Matt Grausam, Peter Roufs, and Brenda Walden.
Msgr. Lozinski led the opening prayer with Liturgy of the Hours.
October 2019 minutes were approved. Agenda was approved.
2. Pastor's Comments – A meeting with all of the Admin. Councils and committees/parish staff will be held January 28. Pastoral planning continues to be an issue; looking into reorganizing AFC with some possible mergers. Options for a new parish Mission Statement were reviewed.
3. Worship and Spiritual Life Committee – Deacon McKeown suggested “Casting Nets Ministries” as a possible mission for the AFC after Easter. More adorers are needed for Perpetual Adoration and two each hour, as originally intended, is encouraged.
4. Evangelization and Catechesis – Peter Roufs reported that a plan is in place to welcome St. Michael's students; a middle school (gr. 6-8) is being considered, and the football co-op proposed by public school for next year was discussed.
5. Religious Education – Japanese Martyrs and St. Paul's parish has 14 CCD combined. The program is going well. Confirmation will be held on March 8.
6. Adult Ed – That Man is You and ChristLife continue, Dan Davis is instructing three people in RCIA, and the youth group continues to meet Wednesday nights.
7. Stewardship – The Christmas collection was good. The budget process for next year has begun.
8. Maintenance – The handicapped pews are complete, gym/auditorium/fldhouse floors need to be done, AC units for school, and exchange unit in the kitchen were discussed.
9. Next meeting – March 16. Closing Prayer led by Msgr. Lozinski.
