2. Pastor's Comments – AFC Pastoral Council meets in two weeks as they continue to work on the mission statement and try to develop the financial responsibilities.
3. Worship and Spiritual Life Committee - Lent is going well with fair attendance at Stations of the Cross and good attendance at the daily Masses.
4. Evangelization and Catechesis – In the discussion surrounding the revision of the Sexual Misconduct policy of the Diocese, it was noted that all members of committees/boards working directly with policies involving youth will need a background check. This will affect our E and C committee. Peter Roufs is pleased to see the school and community working together with the musical.
5. Adult Formation – TMIY is going well with about 30-40 men attending on a regular basis. Mission speaker for the AFC will be Fr. John Kubicki to be held November 17-20. The Christ Life program continues. Msgr. Lozinski asked the members for suggestions for summer adult education.
6. Sacramental Programs – Msgr. Lozinski reported that the second grade parents held their first meeting on Sunday.
7. Stewardship – Matt Grausam reviewed the proposed budget reflecting a deficit. The finance committee will continue to work on it. We also reviewed the consolidated statement for the eight months ending February 2019.
8. Maintenance – Josh Sellner reported the high school doors will be replaced soon.
9. Next meeting – May 20, 2019. Closing Prayer led by Msgr. Lozinski.
