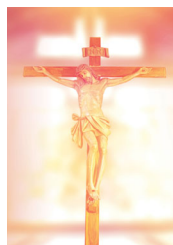

HERE'S SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT!

If you ever want to have a baptism, wedding, other sacrament, or funeral at St. Michael's, or if you are asked to be someone's godparent or confirmation sponsor, you must have been a registered (and preferably active!) parishioner for at least three months. All too often people assume that just because they attend Mass at a particular church, they are automatically members. However, unless a family or individual is formally enrolled, the church has no way to know who is a parishioner. This 'paper trail' is needed for sacramental documentation. Most importantly, registration lets the parish know it can count on you to assist in its mission. Registering with your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your church, fellow parishioners, and pastor.
