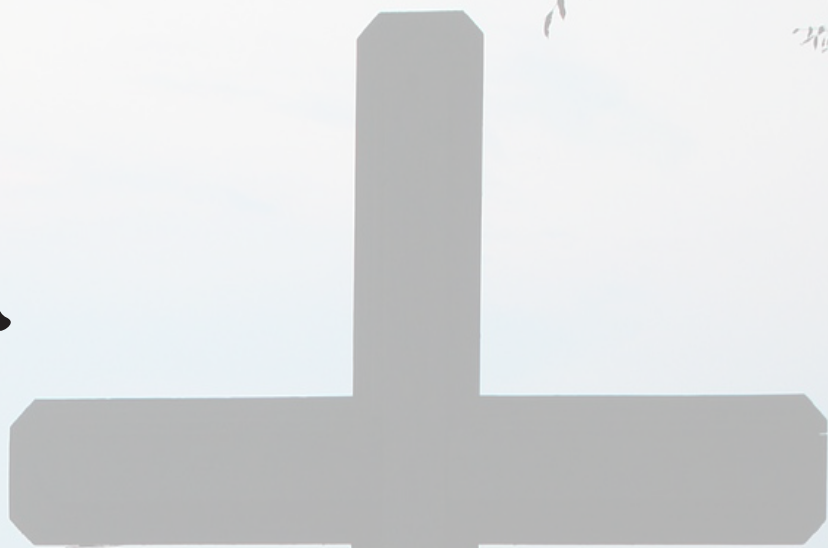

Guidelines for Lenten Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

Abstinence (from meat only) for all over 14 years of age.
On these two days, *fast*, as well as *abstinence*, is also
obligatory for those from ages 18-59.

Abstinence means refraining from meat. Fast means
one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing
between meals (liquids are permitted). No Catholic will
lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation.

All other Fridays in Lent

All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
Here again Catholics will not hold themselves lightly
excused, but if there is a serious health problem, this
obligation would not apply.

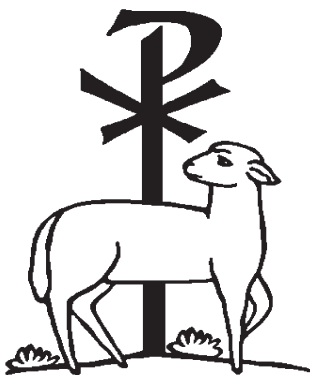
