Old Business

- 1) Approve previous meeting minutes
 - a. Teri moved to accept. John seconded
 - i. Unanimously approved

Committee Reports

- 1) Finance
 - a. Sale of Land on VV finalized
 - b. Covid payroll loan officially forgiven
- 2) Buildings and Grounds
 - a. Monches Church sacristy roof repaired on April 13th by Over the Top Roofing
 - b. Citywide Masonry putting together estimates for church and rectory tuckpointing at Monches
 - c. Slab-work and landscaping for St. Teresa statue will be installed this spring
 - i. Committee approved expenditure of \$1260
 - d. Edgework, landscaping, and mulching of the grounds will be done
 - i. Committee approved expenditure of \$540
 - e. Spring cleanup happened on April 24th
 - f. Lawn mowers were taken in for maintenance - the Toro mower from the cemetery required \$828 in repairs and the church mower needed \$190 worth of service.
 - g. Regarding the Columbariums at both cemeteries: The quote for concrete foundation and flatwork is still valid. The quote for erection of the Columbariums will be reviewed since these quotes are nearly two years old. Three benches and minimal landscaping will be provided between the two sites.

- h. Regarding the four windows for the North Lake rectory dinette and dining room installed on February 24th: George performed needed stain on some trim and the window screens were delivered.
 - i. Deacon Allen is in process of getting quotes for the restoration and/or replacement of the west doors church doors and the door at the SW corner, as well as the Monches church west doors, with moldings as necessary. A quote for "crash bars" will be included to meet safety codes.
 - j. Mary Jo requested that minutes recognize that a parishioner, Carol Leonard, needs some indoor handy-man assistance at her home. Contact her at 262-366-0963. Mike S. said he would call her.
